

How to Use Fluorouracil (5FU) Cream

It is best to apply 5FU cream once at night before bed. A typical course of 5FU cream is 2-4 weeks. The provider will ask that you make a follow-up appointment to recheck the area 2 weeks into your course. This is to ensure an appropriate reaction is occurring.

- 1. Clean the area where you will apply 5FU cream with water. Rinse well, dry the area with a towel, and wait ten minutes before application of 5FU cream.
- 2. Apply 5FU cream as directed, using your fingertips. Only a small amount is necessary, just enough to cover the affected skin.
- 3. Avoid contact with your eyes, nostrils, and mouth.
- 4. Wash your hands as soon as you finish applying 5FU cream to your skin.
- 5. Wash off in the morning with water or gentle cleanser and apply moisturizer and/or sunscreen. If the area is itching or tight-feeling, a thicker moisturizer like Aquaphor or Vaseline may be soothing
- 6. Sunlight may increase your side effects. When exposed to sunlight, wear a wide-brimmed hat and use a zinc based sunscreen with SPF of at least 30.
